## Nurturing School


Our focus principle of nurture this week is:

### All behaviour is communication

This nurture principle reminds us that all behaviour – both good and bad – is one way a person can tell us how they are feeling.

Lots of behaviours indicate where children feel anxious or stressed. We assess and track children's behaviour to allow us to identify where extra support is necessary.

We also work with a number of external agencies to provide expert support and advice when needed.



To improve home/school communication, we are trialling ClassDojo. We will use it as a messaging system as it will allow us to quickly message parents.

Furthermore, as a parent, you will be able to see every time your children receive points from their teacher allowing you to celebrate their successes with them. Parents will shortly receive an email explaining how it works.

### **School Dinners**

Children can now choose a jacket potato with a choice of tuna, beans and/or cheese in the morning at registration without any prior notice.

Due to rising costs, from September, school dinner prices will increase to £2.75 (£2.00 for nursery). Meals will be subsidised by school funds as school are charged £3.03 per meal.

### **Multiplication Check**

Year 4 children will take their multiplication check in the week beginning Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June.

Quick recall of times tables (answering a question within six seconds without counting in multiples) is shown by research to have a positive effect on later maths outcomes.



Every child from year 1 up has a Times Table Rock Stars account which they can access at home. In KS2, it is expected (and is a part of our homework policy) that children will access TTRS for half an hour each week outside of school hours.
